Role and Responsibilities

- Coordinate, schedule and advise the volunteers and paid childcare workers for nursery through 5th grade age groups, thorough oversight
- · Order curriculum for all children education programs
- Ensure all teachers and staff have lesson plans by Thursday of the Sunday they are responsible for leading,
- Print lesson plans for preschool room and put in binder. Get any necessary supplies to support lesson.
- Print Children's Church lesson, make copies of handouts, and gather supplies for lesson weekly
- Recruitment and training of teachers and assistants, training of these volunteers.
- Arranging and managing substitutes as needed.
- Create and equip the Children's Ministry Team to plan, budget, and present special events that address the needs of our children and young families for fellowship and Christian education. There should be at least one quarterly event for children and/or families for both spiritual/social and service-oriented fellowship.
- Organize Vacation Bible School each summer by recruiting volunteers, reviewing and providing curriculum, registering participants, and implementing the program.
- Supervise the Nursery Paid Staff by arranging for nursery coverage for specific church events and all worship services, checking and signing off on their weekly time-sheets, providing annual evaluations, holding regular staff meetings/trainings and making recommendations for hiring, firing, yearly review and suggested pay increases to the Lead Pastor(s).
- Support families in helping them to grow their child(ren's) faith by providing resources to be used at home
- Plan and lead summer preschool group: Books, Bubbles, and Buddies
- Lead an annual Sunday School Teacher Training
- Promote children's participation in worship for children through oversight of
 coloring pages that go along with the sermon themes, preparing the worship bags
 for children and by encouraging involvement by finding children to volunteer to
 serve communion, and serve as greeters.
- Update and enforce the Child Protection Policy of The Gathering at Scott Memorial UMC.
- Communicate and advertise the Children's programs by providing information for bulletins, newsletters, new member's packets, Facebook, the website, family ministry newsletter and other means of communication. Prepare needed clip board sign-up sheets and following up with those who sign up.
- Maintain Facebook Gatherlings page (Facebook group for parents)
- Attend staff meetings as scheduled (estimated monthly meetings).
- Attend continuing education events as needed and feasible, giving special consideration to those events sponsored by the United Methodist Church.

- Organize Children's church (during worship service, after children's moment, about 20 minutes, children return for communion) and train and equip volunteers in this ministry
- Organize and maintain files of background checks on all children's ministry volunteers and paid staff
- Perform any additional tasks relating to children's ministry as requested by Executive Director and/or Lead Pastor(s)

Qualifications/Skills

- The Director of Children Ministries has the primary responsibility of coordinating the ministries program of the church for infants through 5th grade.
- A working knowledge of theology, a philosophy of education, and willingness to adhere to the guidelines of the Book of Discipline of the United Methodist Church.
- Ability to work closely with the Children's Ministry Team, Sunday School and Christian education volunteers, and Nursery workers, to provide meaningful and effective ministry with children
- Relational skills in working with children and their parents
- Must embrace Christian discipline and United Methodist doctrine and theology.
- Must have vision and a demonstrated ability to plan, develop, coordinate, manage and implement a children's ministry within the parameters of the United Methodist Church.
